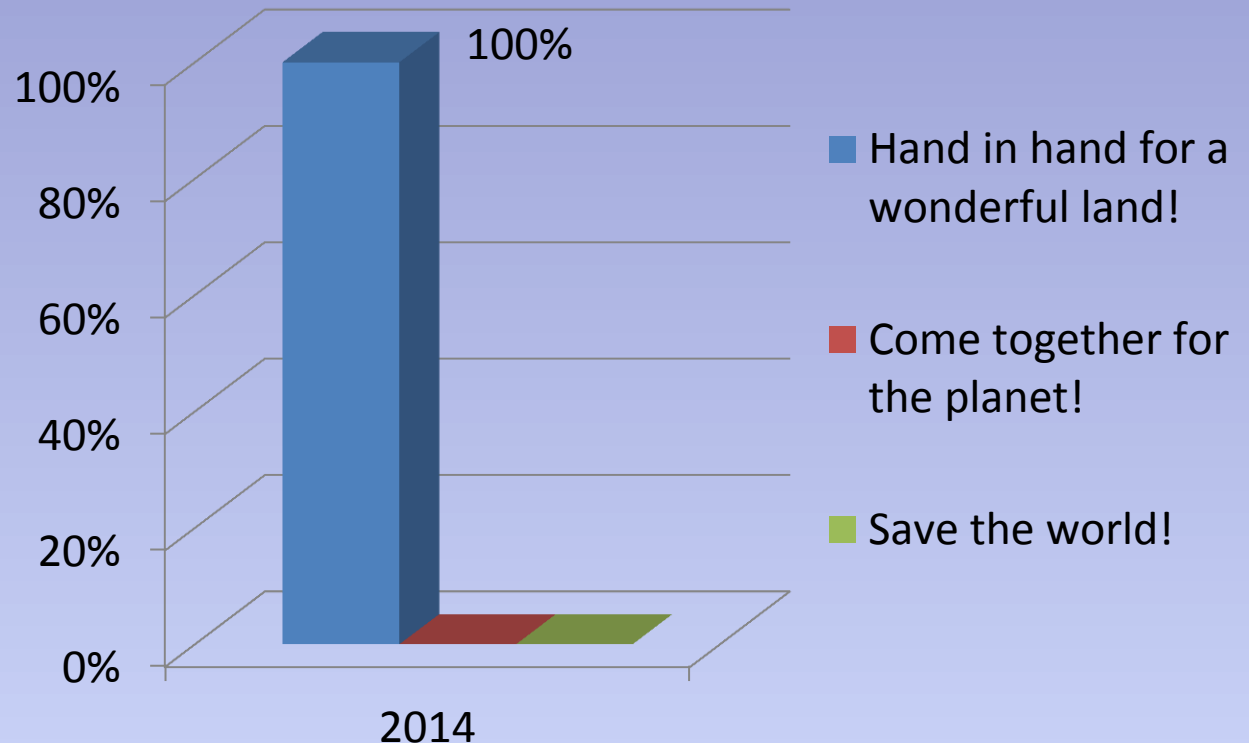

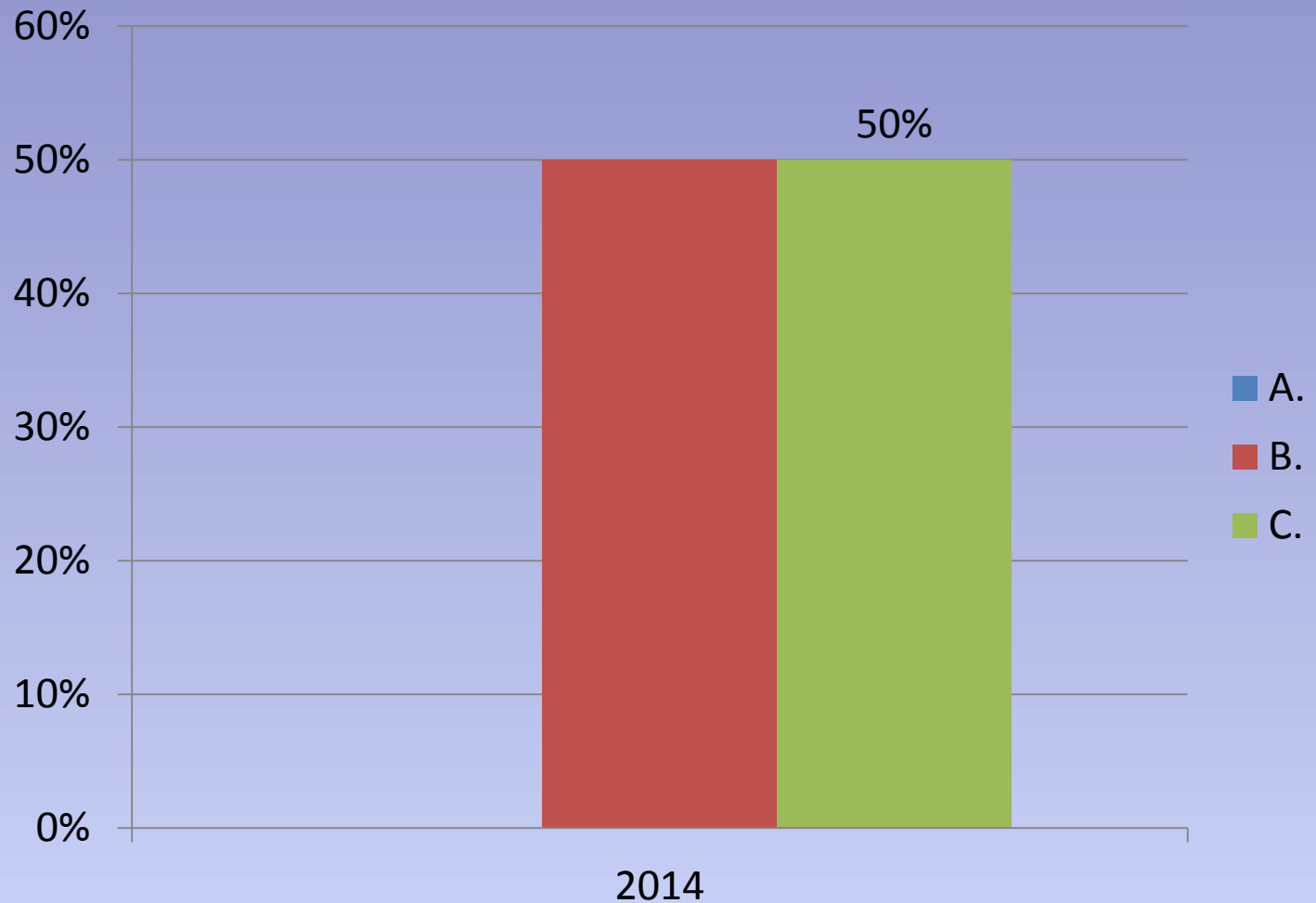
1. What's the name of the Comenius Project focusing on the environmental problems?

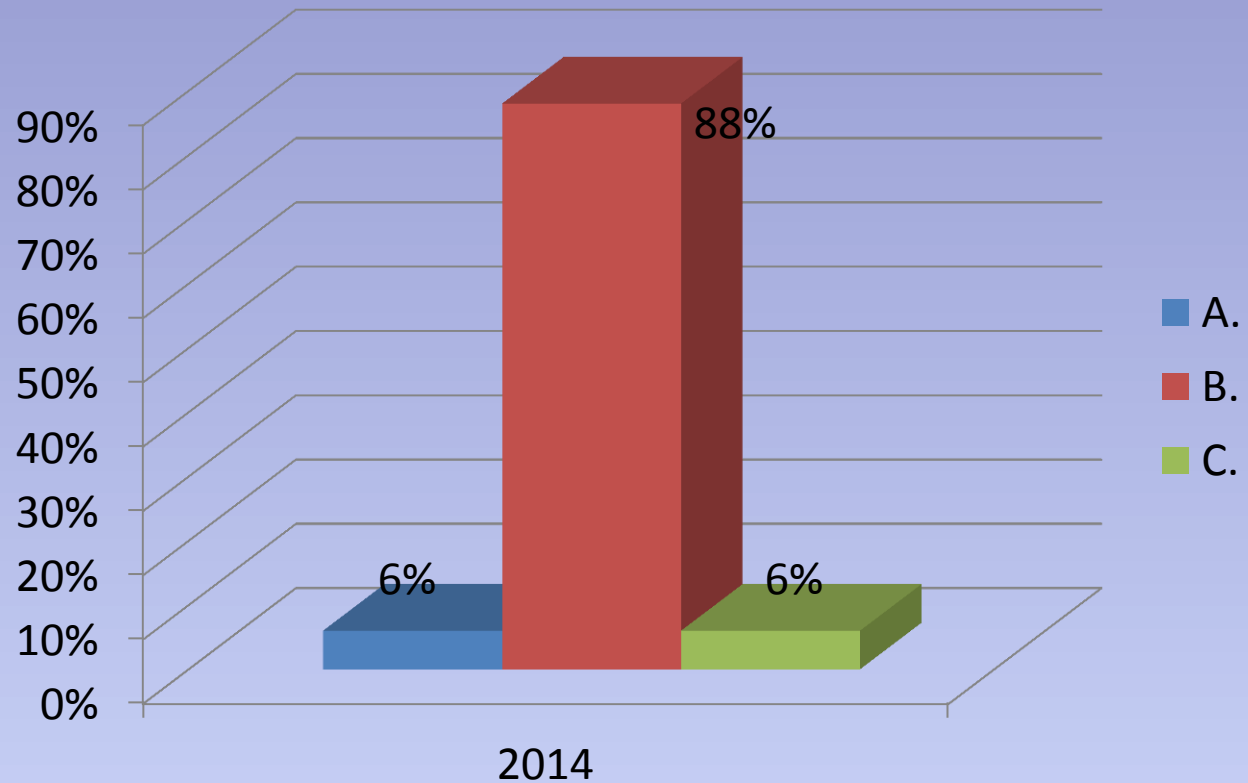
2. How many countries are involved in this project?

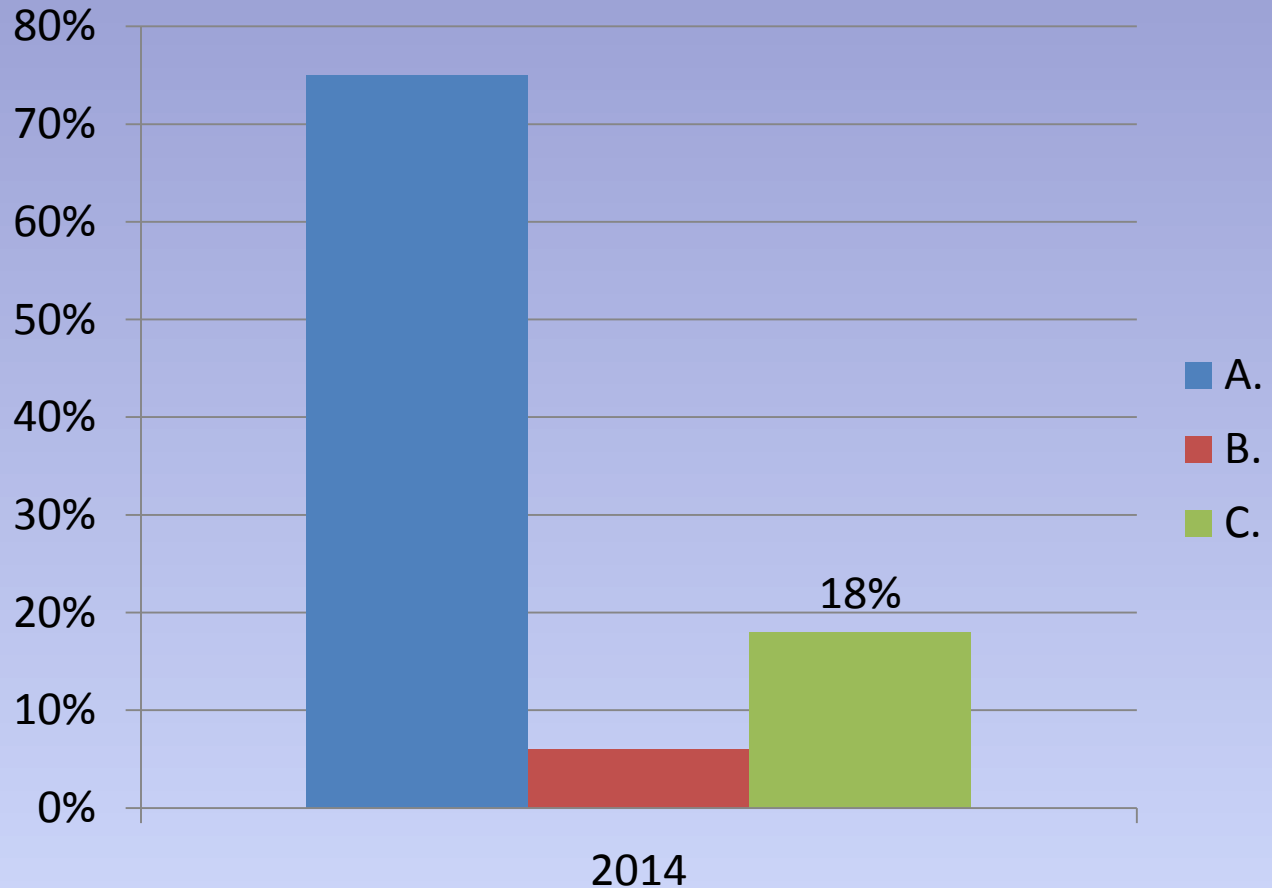
3. How would you describe the quality of the environment where you live?

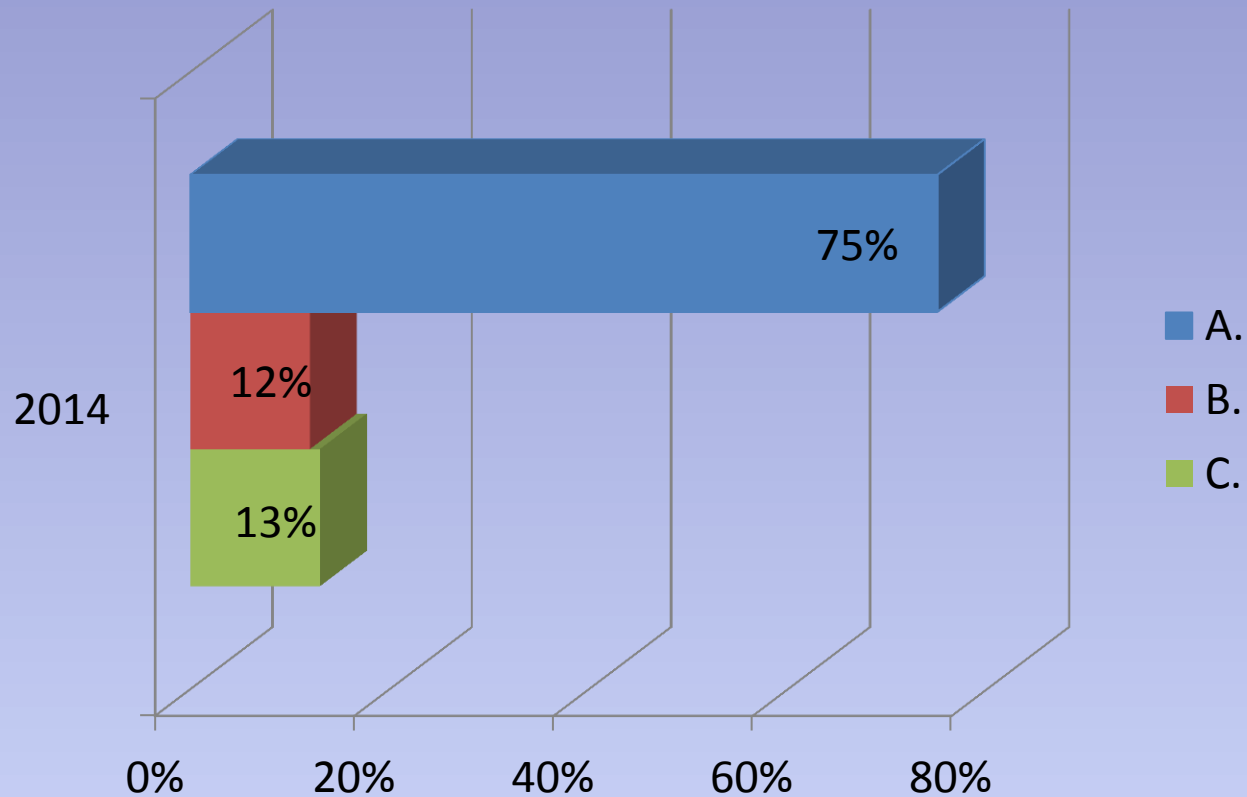
4. Who should take care of educating people about the environmental problems/issues?

- C. Because dogs' owners do not remove the waste of their pets.

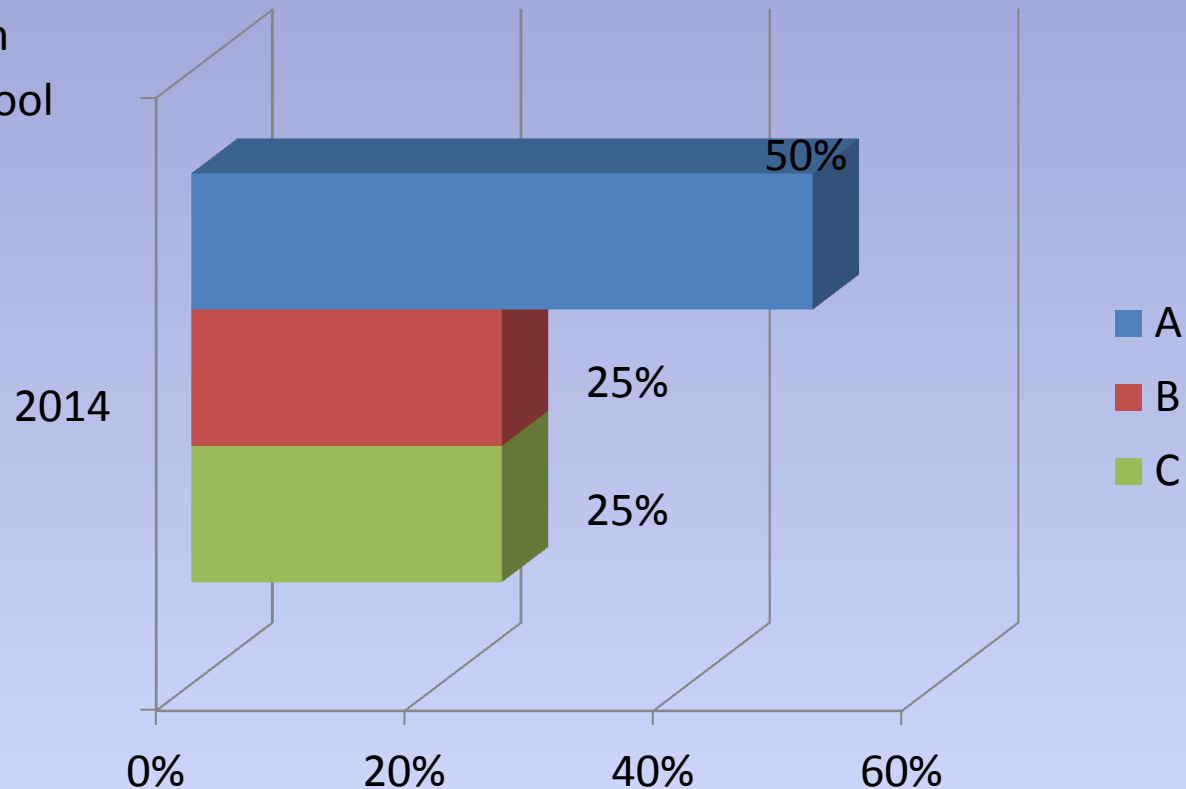


6. How do you think we could raise awareness and improve environmentally friendly procedures in our school community?

A. Through civic education in curricular lessons.

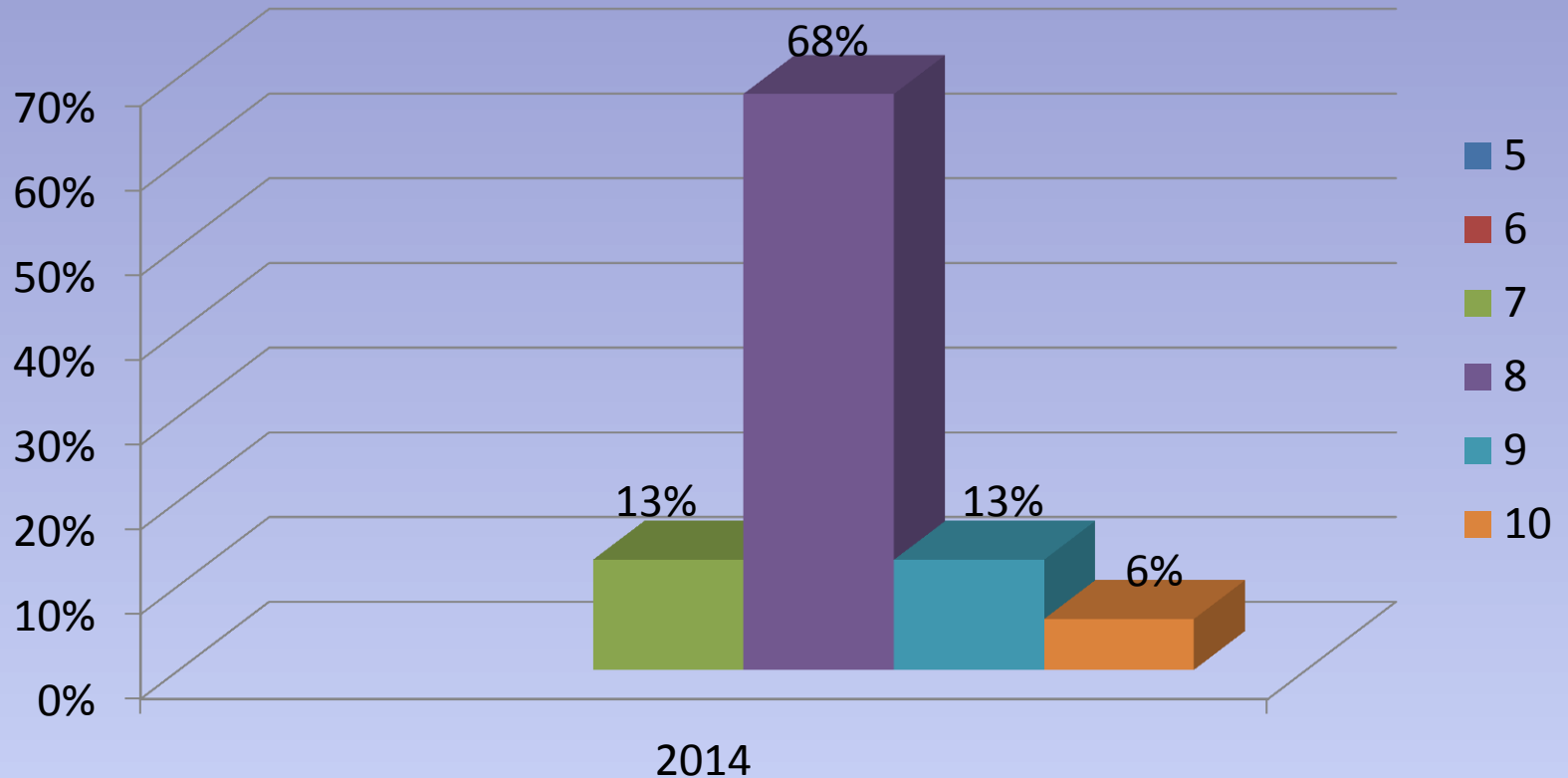

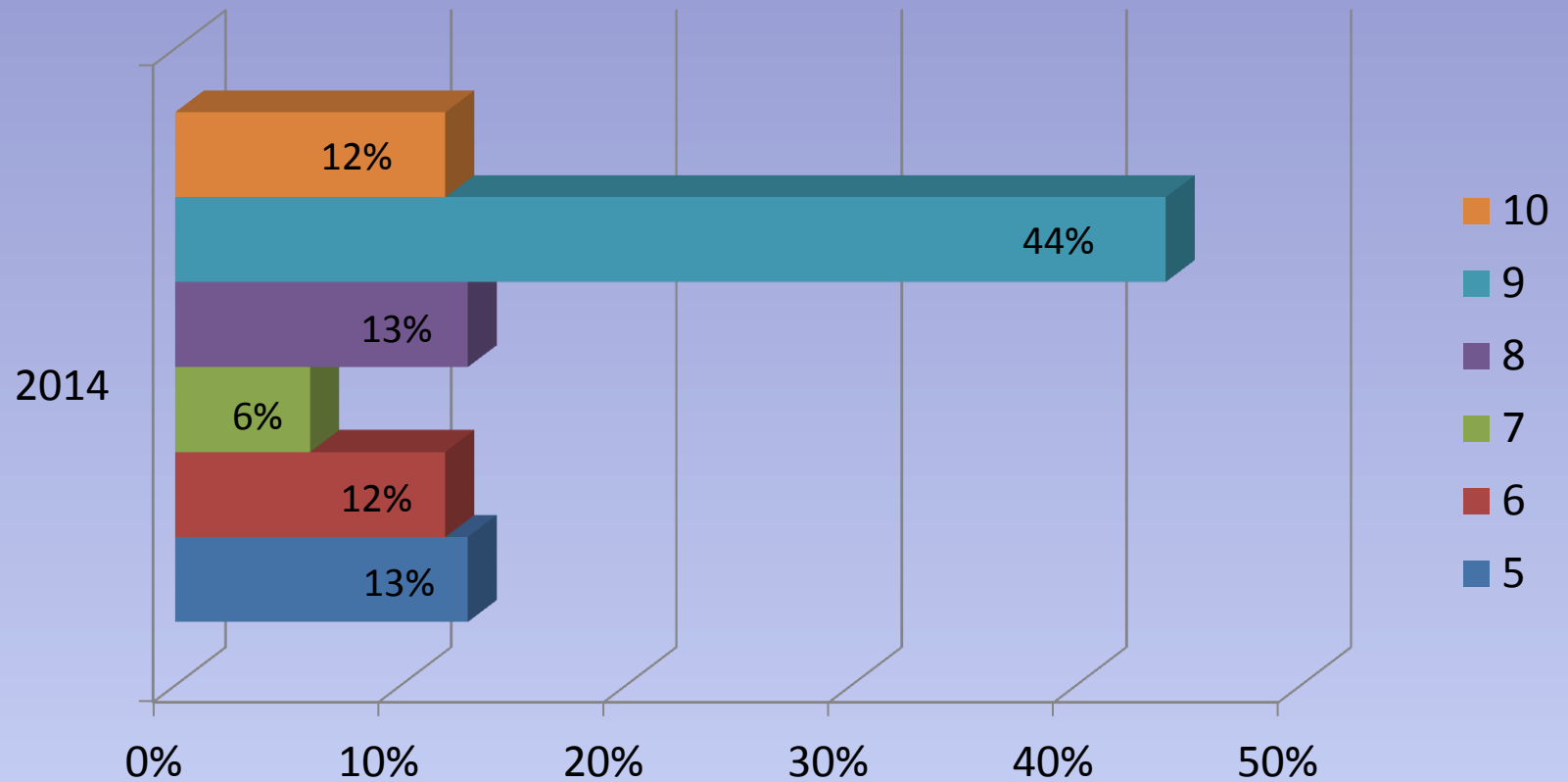
7. Do you think that waste sorting is carried out adequately in your school?

(Rate 0-10 where 0 is 'inadequate' and 10 is 'more than adequate'



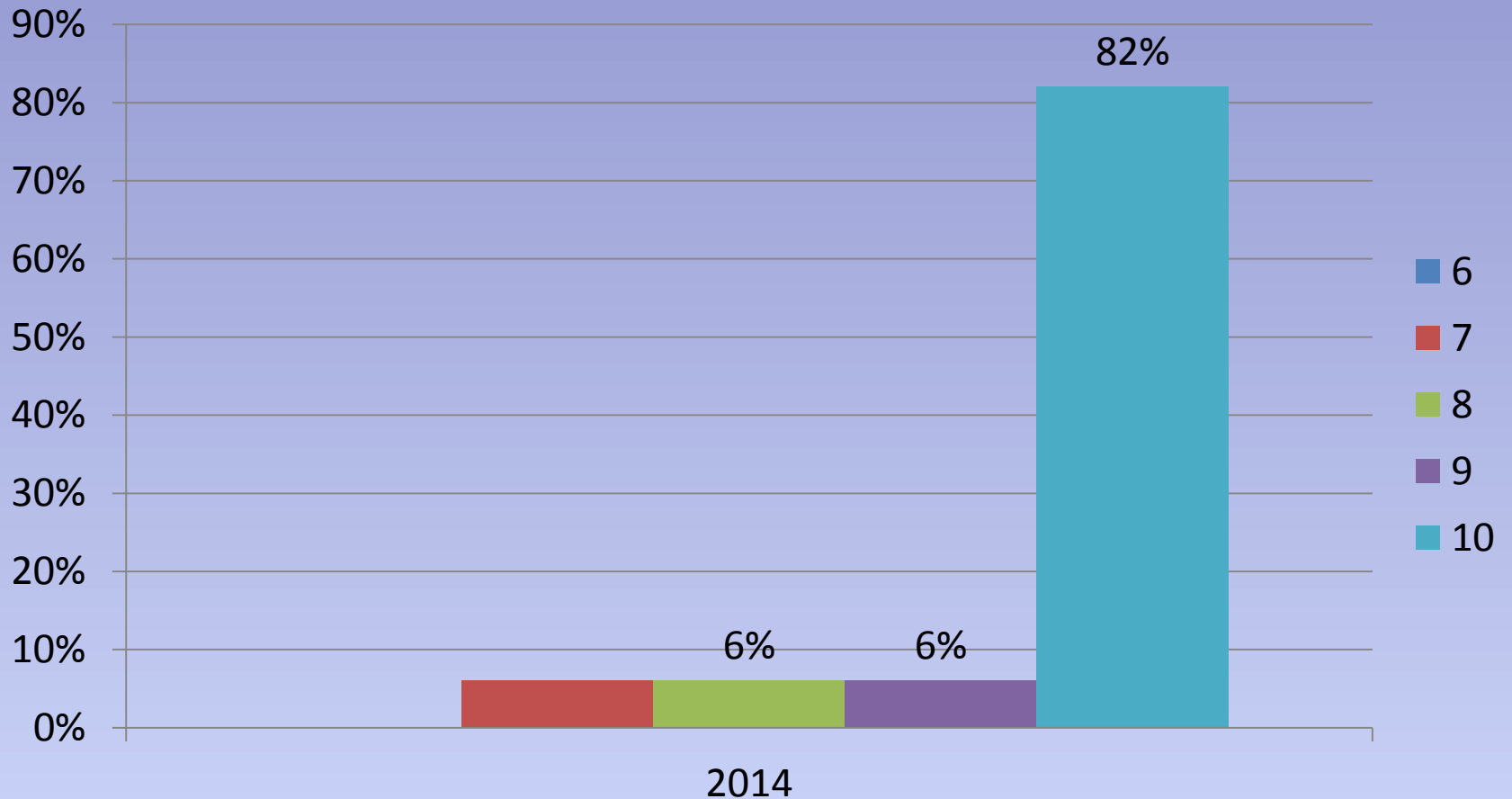
8. How much do you know about the environmental beauties of the partner countries?
